The Village of Ridgefield Park was settled in 1685 and proudly holds one of the longest continuous Fourth of July parades in New Jersey.


The Village is a rich source of American history and the Public Library, located at 107 Cedar Street, is a great place to learn more. Please stop by!

Each member is required to complete an 80-hour Heavy Rescue Certification course and must serve a six month probationary period before becoming a regular member. Some members are also certified fire fighters. Ambulance Corps


Our Ambulance Corps is a fully volunteer BLS Provider dedicated to providing Ridgefield Park and surrounding areas with 911 medical services. The Corps is intended to be a 24/7/365 service. Presently, due to a manpower shortage and an insufficient number of people with EMT certification, our not-for-profit organization has taken a step back and is working to rebuild. Anyone interested in joining will receive EMT training. We are working to ensure members reach the highest standards to once again serve the Village.

As well, EMT certifications present a wealth of opportunity outside the doors of the Ambulance Corps. Former members have utilized their certification and skills for other jobs, as well as the safety and well-being of their own families. We will educate anyone willing to learn who intends to serve the village with the highest priority.




Police Department


